Interim City Manager Clay Goodman noted that this is a complex budget and the purpose of this meeting was for review and discussion of funding for major projects and needs for the City. He advised Council to keep options open which could include a tax increase.

David Bryant, Director of Finance and HR, presented an overview of projected revenue with no tax increase proposed. He noted the major increase in CSA funding requests. Items in this request had increased 100% to over 200% in some areas. There was much discussion regarding this issue and the concern of this as a State mandated service.

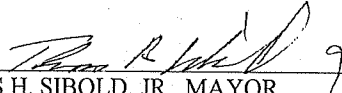
Allen Dressler, Director of Parks and Public Works, presented information regarding paving, repairing/replacing the walkway into Thacker Ave., bridge repairs and drainage issues with 5 projects noted. He proposed the development of a storm drain plan. The Rayon Bridge was discussed and the entire structure needs replaced. This bridge is inspected annually for safety and could, at some point, be required to close to traffic.
