

MINUTES
CALLED MEETING
JULY 7, 2020 5:30 P.M.

A called meeting of the Council for the City of Covington was held on Tuesday, July 7, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 333 W. Locust Street, Covington, Virginia.


The meeting was called to order by Mayor Thomas H. Sibold, Jr. with the following members present: Mayor Sibold, Vice Mayor David S. Crosier, Councilman Raymond C. Hunter and Councilman S. Allan Tucker. Councilman Edmond J. "Eddie Joe" Entsminger was absent.

The purpose of the meeting was to review sections of the City Code.

City Attorney Popovich presented an overview of the Omnibus Ordinance which incorporated items such as clearing references of the old Virginia State Code, stating accurate offices and locality references. He also noted that a fee schedule was adopted with the budget which removes references to fees in the code. The first step that was taken in revising the code was to establish a set of By-laws for Council which clarified meeting information, practices and procedures. These By-laws can be revised anytime Council may wish to do so.

Discussion was held regarding which sections Council may want to address at the next code work session.

No further business to come before Council, the meeting was adjourned.
