Seasonal Allergies	Abrupt	Differs depending on the allergen	Runny Nose/stuffy nose Sneezing • Red, swollen eyes • Itchy eyes and nose	Wheezing, shortness of breath (more common for those with asthma)	
Cold	Gradual onset	Most occur during fall and winter but can be year-round	Runny nose • Sneezing • Sore throat • Aches and pains • Mild cough	Fatigue	Fever Headaches
Strep Throat	Abrupt (sore throat)	Can occur year-round with increased cases in winter months	Sore throat • Painful swallowing • Fever • Swollen lymph nodes	Headache Rash	
Flu	Quick onset	Most occur October through May	Fever • Dry Cough • Headache • Fatigue	Runny Nose Sore throat Sneezing	Diarrhea
COVID-19	Gradual (2-14 days)	Unknown	Fever • Dry cough • Shortness of breath	Fatigue • Aches and pains • Headache • Sore throat • Chills	Nausea/Vomiting/ Diarrhea • Loss of taste or smell
