

MINUTES
CALLED MEETING
JANUARY 5, 2021

6:30 p.m.


A called meeting of the Council for the City of Covington was held on Tuesday, January 5, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., telecommunicated electronically from the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 333 W. Locust Street, Covington, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by City Clerk Rebecca Scott with all members present electronically as follows: Mayor Sibold, Vice Mayor David S. Crosier, Councilman William E. Carson, Jr., Councilman Raymond C. Hunter, and Councilman S. Allan Tucker.

The meeting was held electronically via Zoom. Mrs. Scott read a statement declaring that due to the COVID-19 Coronavirus health emergency and pursuant to Chapter 1283 of the 2020 Acts of Assembly, Council would convene electronically for this called meeting to transact the business statutorily required or necessary to continue the operations of the City. On a motion by Vice Mayor Crosier and seconded by Mr. Tucker, Council voted unanimously to conduct the meeting electronically with the following votes: Mr. Sibold: For; Mr. Crosier: For; Mr. Carson: For; Mr. Hunter: For; and Mr. Tucker: For.

The purpose of the meeting was to organize Council and elect the offices of mayor and vice mayor. When the floor was opened for nominations, Mr. Tucker made a motion to re-elect the same slate of officers, with Mr. Sibold for mayor and Mr. Crosier for vice mayor. Mr. Carson seconded the motion. The vote showed Mayor Sibold: For; Vice Mayor Crosier: For; Mr. Carson: For; Mr. Hunter: For; and Mr. Tucker: For.

With no further business to come before Council, the meeting was adjourned by consensus after a motion from Vice Mayor Crosier, seconded by Mr. Tucker.
