	<p><u>ADDITIONAL NOTES for 2/1/2021:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The 8430 figure does not include doses distributed to pharmacies and regional jail. By their reports, these agencies had redistributed vaccine in arms by 1/31/2021. Last week, more than 500 second doses were released as first doses and in arms by the end of this week per request from the Central Office. <p><i>With the above efforts 100% of both first and second doses of vaccine received by RCAHD through 1/28/21 was off the shelves for the week ending on 1/29/2021.</i></p>		

*Vaccine received/used is the number of vials x advertised doses/ vial. For Moderna, there are 10 doses/ vial, for Pfizer, 5 doses/ vial. The actual total number of people vaccinated exceeds the number of doses by vial here because it is common to get an extra-dose out of the vials.
