Public Safety Specialist

General Description

This position performs responsible protective service work involving a variety of support duty Public Safety assignments; does related work as required. Much of the work is performed of a wide variety of semiskilled miscellaneous maintenance tasks. May include working under emergency conditions depending on qualifications. Work is performed under the regular supervision of Director of Public Safety or designee.

Requirements/Preferences

Be at least 18 years of age, pass physical and a drug screening test. Possess a valid Commonwealth of Virginia driver's license. EMT Basic or Firefighter I/II certification, Emergency Vehicle Operation Course.

Salary and Benefits

Starting salary will be based on qualifications. City offers a generous benefits package including health insurance, life insurance, VRS retirement, paid leave and holidays. Following a conditional offer of employment, applicant must pass a physical examination and drug test.
